Source	Type	Notes
PubMed	Bibliographic database	A free database accessing the MEDLINE database of citations, abstracts and some full text articles on life sciences and biomedical topics.
Agricola	Bibliographic database	A primary public source for world-wide access to agricultural information. The database covers materials in all formats and periods, including printed works from as far back as the 15th century.
CAB Abstracts*	Bibliographic database	Journal citation index focusing on agricultural and plant science papers.
CABI Crop Protection Compendium*	Compendium	An encyclopaedic tool that brings together a wide range of different types of science-based information on all aspects of crop protection. Contains pest profiles with key diagnostic information therein.
ISI Web of Knowledge*	Bibliographic database	Definitive journal citation index
APS Journals	Website covering the journals published by the American Phytopathological Society	This includes Phytopathology and Plant Disease. Both journals often publish new diagnostic methods. Access to full text of articles is free a year after publication.
