<b>Conditions of Entry</b>							
1. This shipment to be accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate issued by a duly authorized Plant Quarantine Officer of the country of origin and must be absolutely free from soil.							
2. Immediately upon arrival of the plant materials are sent to the Plant Quarantine Service for inspection.							
3. If the plant materials are found upon inspection to be infested with pests or disease they can be destroyed.							
4. Containers to specify the nature of the contents.
